AHRA Announces November 2003 Certified Radiology Administrator (CRA) Examination Results

(Sudbury, MA, December 22, 2003) – The American Healthcare Radiology Administrators (AHRA) announced today that 74% of the 46 radiology administrators who took the November 7, 2003 examination received a passing score and are now Certified Radiology Administrators. They may be recognized by the credential, CRA, after their name. There are approximately 360 Certified Radiology Administrators nationwide. The CRA is the industry's first certification program for radiology administrators and is administered by the Radiology Administration Certification Commission of the AHRA. The CRA program is designed to elevate professional standards, enhance individual performance and recognize administrators who demonstrate knowledge essential to the practice of radiology management. The program is funded by a five-year grant from Eastman Kodak Company, Health Imaging Division.

To sit for the examination, candidates were required to meet experience, education, and other credential requirements. AHRA's web site (<http://www.ahraonline.org>) contains a description of the eligibility requirements. The test consisted of 185 questions. Approximately 30 percent of the questions were based on knowledge, 40 percent tested application skills (problem solving) and 30 percent involved analysis. The test questions focused on five domains: human resource management, asset resource management, fiscal management, operations management, and communications and information management.

AHRA continues to develop test dates and locations for the CRA examination and will release new information as it becomes available. In addition, to help candidates prepare for the CRA examination, AHRA and CASTLE Worldwide have made available an optional online practice test, built to the same specifications as the actual examination.

AHRA is extremely grateful to Kodak Health Imaging, who committed \$1 million over five years to fund this exciting new opportunity.
